
1. PLAN

- Organise




2. LOOK

- Is the website up to date? Current
- Relevant Is the information what you need?
 - Author
 - Purpose

- Who wrote the information?
 - What is the website for?

3. DO

- Make notes
- Present
- Produce



Make Notes


- NEVER cut and paste
- ALWAYS use your own words
- Use bullet points
- Write down key information

Read the information. Is it relevant? Is it important? If so, write it down in your OWN WORDS straight away along with the name of the website.




Organise your notes

- Use a different A4 sheet for each heading
- Write your notes under the best heading
- Create a new heading if you need to
- Use bullet points to write your notes
- Write down where you got the information from

- Reflect
- Evaluate
- Feedback
