### S3 Pathways

- Last week you had a practice at completing a Pathways form, indicating your preferred subjects for \$3
- Now that you have your S2 Reports you are required to complete this process to make your final choices for S3
- Hopefully you have taken some time to think about your career and have done some research around the qualifications you will need to facilitate this.
- So, before we outline what happens now, we will quickly recap how you will select your subjects across all the curricular areas.

# Broad General Education

- In S3 all pupils continue to follow a broad general education across 8 curricular areas.
- The curricular areas are:
- ▶1 Languages/Literacy
- ▶2 Maths/Numeracy
- ▶ 3 Social Studies
- ▶ 4 Science
- ▶ 5 Expressive Arts
- ▶6 Technologies
- ▶7 Health & Wellbeing
- ▶8 Religious & Moral Education
- ► You will narrow down from 17 classes in S2 to 11 in S3. The 11 classes are made up of 8 subjects plus core PE, PSE and RP.

# S3 Pathways Process

Everyone **MUST** continue to study subjects across the 8 curricular areas.

The following subjects do not appear on the pathways form as everyone continues with them in S3:

- English/Literacy
- Maths/Numeracy
- Health & Wellbeing (PE & PSE)
- Religious and Moral Education (RP)

This covers 4 of the 8 curricular areas.


# S3 Pathways Process

you have a choice of which subject you would like to continue with. You must choose 1 subject in each area.

#### Personalisation

Once you have chosen 1 subject from each of Social Studies, Science, Expressive Arts and Technologies you now have 9 subjects.

- English / Literacy
- Maths/Numeracy
- One from Social subjects
- One from Science
- One from Expressive Arts
- One from Technologies
- Core PE, PSE and RP

These 9 subjects span across the 8 compulsory curricular areas.

#### Personalisation

Finally, you have 2 more subjects to choose to allow you to continue with 11 subjects in S3.

You have a free choice for these two subjects.

From the table of subjects on the Pathways Form you must choose 3 subjects you would be happy to continue with. We will then do our very best to ensure that you are allocated 2 out of your 3 choices.

### And finally.....Senior Phase

When you go into the Senior Phase (S4 – S6) you study even fewer subjects.

In S4 you will only study 6 subjects you choose in S3 plus the core subjects of PE and Personal Development.

In S5 you will study 5 subjects from the 6 in S4 plus Personal Development and Leadership.

In S6 you will study a minimum of 4 Subjects, but most pupils will continue with 5.

#### What's next

- Take a Pathways Form.
- ► Look at your S2 Report to identify subjects you are successful in.
- ► Think about what you want to do when you leave school.
- ▶ Discuss your possible choices with your parents/carers. Remember there's a Parents Information Evening (in school) on Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> January at 6pm that both you and your Parents/Carers should attend.
- ► Think about the subjects you'd like to choose from columns A to D.
- ► Think about your 3 free choice subjects. You will only be allocated 2 of these so ensure you're happy with all 3 subjects (these are not prioritised the aim is to give you any 2 from 3)
- From Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> January you will be invited for a Pathways interview with Mr Bulloch, Ms Loudon, Mrs Marinello, or Mr Mackenzie, who will complete a pathways interview with you to confirm your choices are appropriate for you.
